1.0 REPORT PURPOSE AND SCOPE

- The design, installation, conditions of use and identification of the Elco Dril-Flex[®] Self-Drilling Structural Screws are in accordance with the 2018 International Building Code[®] (2018 IBC) provisions noted in the evaluation report <u>ESR-3332</u>.
- The design, installation and inspection are in accordance with additional requirements of LABC Chapters 16 and 17, as applicable.
- Steel members shall have a minimum ultimate tensile strength of 58-ksi.
- Under the LARC, an engineered design in accordance with LARC Section R301.1.3 must be submitted.
